

- Approche ascendant (**bottom up**)
- La mobilité est une condition essentielle
- Tout niveau de carrière
- 4 différents actions:
 - Actions individuelles: **Individual Fellowships**
 - Actions institutionnelles: **RISE, COFUND, ITN**





RISE: Research and Innovation Staff Exchange

- But: Partage de connaissances
- Détachement de membres du personnel (1-12 mois)
- Staff: chercheurs, membres du personnel (fonctions de direction, techniques ou administratives)
- Call ferme le 5 mai 2017



ITN: Innovative Training Networks

- But: former une nouvelle génération de chercheurs de niveau doctoral
- **Formations de recherche conjointes** par des réseaux internationaux (organisations universitaires & non universitaires) en Europe et au-delà
- 3 modes d'exécutions: Réseaux européens de formation, Doctorats industriels européens , Doctorats communs européens
- Call ferme en janvier 2018



IF: Individual Fellowship

- Bourses individuelles
- accent sur le développement de carrière **de post-doctorants**
- Durée: 1–3 ans
- Deux types: Bourses européennes & bourses mondiales
- Call ferme le 14 septembre 2017



COFUND: Co-funding of regional, national and international programmes

- **Cofinancement de programmes régionaux, nationaux et internationaux, destinés à donner une dimension internationale et intersectorielle à la formation des chercheurs**
- Financer tant les programmes de formation doctorale que les programmes de bourses pour chercheurs chevronnés
- Durée: 3–5 ans
- Call ferme le 28 septembre 2017
